**ADOPTING REVISED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF COLORADO.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado last adopted Summit County Ambulance Licensing Regulations on March 27, 2012 by Resolution No. 2012-19; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in the Colorado Emergency Medical Services Act, C.R.S., 25-3.5-101, et seq., as amended (the "Act"), and the State Board of Health Rules Pertaining to Emergency Medical Services 6 CCR 1015-3 (the "Rules"), the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, are authorized to adopt revised Summit County Emergency Medical Services Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desire to revise the Summit County Emergency Medical Services Rules and Regulations ("EMS Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, the Regulations are intended to prescribe the requirements for the delivery of high quality, coordinated Emergency Medical Services to all visitors and residents in Summit County in accordance with the Colorado Emergency Medical and Trauma Service Act, Title 25, Article 3.5 of the Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds and determines that it is reasonable and in the best interests of the residents of and visitors to Summit County that the Summit County Emergency Medical Services Rules and Regulations be revised.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF COLORADO, THAT:

1. The Summit County Ambulance Licensing Regulations, as provided in Resolution No. 2012-19, are hereby repealed.
2. The Emergency Medical Service Rules and Regulations for Summit County, Colorado, attached as Exhibit "A", are hereby adopted.
