SUBJECT: Application for Licensure of Summit Fire and EMS Replacement Unit

BACKGROUND:

The Director of Emergency Management serves as the Director of the Emergency Medical Service Rules and Regulations for Summit County, Colorado (EMS Regulations). As standard yearly practice, Summit Fire and EMS was approved for ten total units to serve the county for 2020 and Red White and Blue Fire and EMS (RWB) was approved for three total units to serve the county for 2020.

CURRENT SITUATION:

Summit Fire and EMS is submitting an application for the replacement of a currently licensed medic unit. The vehicle that is identified for replacement is a 2014 Dodge 4500 with a vehicle identification number of 3C7WBLBL3EG117330. SFE designates this vehicle as Unit #205.

The vehicle that SFE seeks to replace the existing unit with is a 2020 Ford, vehicle identification number IFDUF4HTILDA00748. If approved by the BOCC, this vehicle will be designated by SFE as Unit #805.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff respectfully recommends that the new vehicle be approved by the BOCC for use as a replacement first line medic unit and a new permit be issued for Vehicle #805 to replace the original 2020 permit issued for Vehicle # 205.
