SUBJECT: Request for Probationary Maintenance of Summit County Road 506

BACKGROUND:

On November 12th, 2019, the BOCC considered accepting County Road 506 for probationary maintenance as a New Business item during the regular meeting. Upon consideration of the criteria and standards, as well as the history of the road and subdivision, it was decided that the Summit County will accept the road for probationary maintenance. The BOCC directed staff to draft a resolution for the next regular meeting, to be adopted as a consent agenda item. The resolution is attached.

ACCEPTING PROBATIONARY ROAD MAINTENANCE STATUS FOR COUNTY ROAD 506

WHEREAS, application has been made to Summit County for probationary maintenance status for County Road 506 as required and outlined by the Summit County Road & Bridge Standards set forth in Section 5500 of the Summit County Land Use and Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the application was reviewed by the Road & Bridge and Engineering Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a public meeting on the application on November 12th, 2019 and has considered the testimony and evidence presented at the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds as follows:

1. The Road is not built substantially in conformance with current County standards, but has been maintained by the County in the past. Given this history, the Board determines that it is appropriate for the County to accept the Road for maintenance on a probationary basis as provided for in §5502.02 of the Summit County Land Use and Development Code.
2. The revenues received and the cost to maintain the road have been considered and deemed acceptable.
3. The current and projected build-out in the development warrants maintenance by Summit County.
4. The overall goals, objectives and budgetary considerations of Summit County in providing safe and efficient maintenance to a majority of the citizens have been considered by the Board and deemed acceptable.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO, THAT COUNTY ROAD 506 IS ACCEPTED FOR PROBATIONARY MAINTENANCE STATUS STARTING IMMEDIATELY, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Summit County Road & Bridge staff will provide snow removal during the 2019/2020 winter season.
2. Summit County Road & Bridge staff will review and discuss the conditions and operation at the end of the 2019/2020 season to evaluate whether it is viable, reasonable and prudent to continue. Staff will report the findings and recommendations resulting from this evaluation to the Board of County Commissioners.
3. All other applicable procedures in Section 5500 et seq of the Code shall remain in full effect.
