RE: 2020 SCWC Grant Program Consent Calendar item for July 14, 2020

On June 18, 2020, SCWC met to provide recommendations for funding projects under the Hazardous Fuels Reduction and the Community Wildfire Protection Plan Implementation Grant programs. This year 12 applications were submitted for funding.

A summary table of the recommended projects are included below in this Consent Calendar staff memo. All of the items listed were vetted by the SCWC and were presented to The Board on July 7, 2020. The SCWC recommends funding all of the projects listed below. In addition to the grant requests, prior funding allocations include the Emergency Fire Fund, CSU Extension staff, chipping campaign outreach education, ongoing grant follow up work conducted by the Weed Control department, and the Chipping Program contractor fee.

This staff memo is provided to recommend the Board support nine (9) Hazardous Fuel Reduction projects totaling \$214,402 and one (1) Community Wildfire Protection Plan Implementation grant totaling \$55,845. The total recommendation for funding is \$270,247.
