I. Building Code 2018 IECC Amendments and Summit County Sustainable Code (Building Inspections)

Jeff Flynn, Jess Hoover and Jim Curnutte gave a presentation and brief overview including but not limited to:

The Building Department staff, along with other building officials in the county, will develop a technical advisory committee to address concerns raised by the Summit County Builders Association regarding the Zero Energy Ready Home Program.

High Country Conservation Center (HC3) will be conducting HERS Rater Trainings for local experienced energy auditors and remodel contractors who wish to become certified raters. The cost of the training will be offset through a partnership with Energy Smart Colorado and the State of Colorado.

The team reviewed the last updates to the Summit Sustainable Building Code (SSBC). The group will present their amended packet for adoption at the March 31, 2020 BOCC Regular Meeting.

II. Managers' and Commissioners' Issues

Senior Management and the Commissioners gave various updates on topics including but not limited to:

Scott Vargo gave an update on the COVID-19 situation in Summit County and the procedures the county has in place should the situation worsen. He also reviewed the sick time policy for county employees who might become sick, as well as arrangements for employees who may need to work from home. Commissioner Stiegelmeier suggested posting information inside the Summit Stage buses for riders. Mr. Vargo also gave a brief update on the mumps cases in the county.

Bentley Henderson gave an update on the following:

- Dillon Dam Road update - Closed indefinitely due to rockslides.
- Transit staffing discussion coming up at the next BOCC Work Session on 3/17/2020.
- Silverthorne Recycling Center Grand Opening will be at 4 p.m. on Wednesday, March 18th.
- New County Planning Director has been hired - April Kroner – coming from the Town of Eagle.

Commissioners also reviewed schedules and upcoming calendar events. Commissioner Lawrence also noted that she received feedback from a recent Early Childhood Options meeting in regards to the Dillon Preschool remodel project – they make seek support from the county.
