Amy Wineland gave an update on the COVID-19 test data and the team discussed the possibility of increasing gathering sizes.

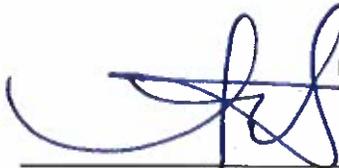
