Sarah Vaine asked if there has been discussion about booster shots and Mr. Henderson said that at this point it seems that the vaccine immunity will last longer than expected but the booster shot is still under review. The group also discussed the issue with breakthroughs, meaning someone fully vaccinated that comes down with a COVID variant.

Public Health Order will continue through June 30, 2021, and no changes are expected until that date.

Communications: Nicole Valentine reported that they are still putting out the message encouraging people to get a vaccine. Adam Kisiel gave an update on the *Jam and Jab Concert Series*, which provides vaccinations along with music. He also updated on the marketing campaigns aimed at individuals who still need to get their second vaccine dose.
