I. Recovery and Resilience Process

Scott Vargo gave an update on Summit County's mask campaign and the efforts in getting the message out to the public and lodging companies so visitors understand the importance of wearing facemasks. Amy noted that the county might see an uptick on positive cases about two weeks after this holiday weekend.

Amy Wineland gave an update on the Protect Your Neighbor phase of the recovery process. She also noted there were some delays on test results last week and this was due to an increase in the number of tests that were submitted to the state lab. The turnaround should be back to normal, which is 24 to 48 hours for results.

Ms. Wineland also explained how visitors and seasonal employees are counted when it comes to positive COVID-19 test results and how they affect the county's case numbers.


II. Review recent COVID-19 test results and the Legal Issues related thereto (Public Health Dept., Attorney) (Executive Session Recommended).
