I. Recovery and Resilience Process

Amy Wineland and Nicole Valentine gave an update on the *Safe Six* program, which will replace the *Five Commitments* and include a recommendation for the public to get the flu vaccine.

Scott Vargo asked for approval to send a combined alert on Saturdays, which will include Stage II Fire Restrictions and face coverings requirements. Commissioners approved. The alerts will continue to be sent in both English and Spanish.

Ms. Wineland and Mr. Vargo gave an update on mobile testing and drive-through testing facilities for the fall and winter seasons. They also noted that the current Public Health order, set to expire at the end of August, will be extended.
