I. Recovery and Resilience Process

Molly Boyd gave an overview of the results of the survey sent to Summit County Government (SCG) employees asking for their thoughts and concerns with their children going back to school. Job flexibility was the most important request, as employees would prefer to work remotely or have a different schedule. Human Resources is looking into different options, especially for essential employees; however, not every department can accommodate these requests due to their hours of operation and/or the need for face-to-face contact.

Amy Wineland shared that Public Health is seeing an uptick on cases due to many people having back-to-school parties, backyard barbeques, etc. Ms. Wineland reminded everyone of the importance of continuing to wear masks and not let their guard down. She also recommended that everyone get a flu shot as soon as it becomes available. Although the Public Health Department hoped to hold a drive-through flu vaccine clinic, it may not be possible due to staffing shortages. Employees can get a flu shot at any location that accepts SCG Health Insurance, which covers the cost of the vaccine.
