I. Recovery and Resilience Process

Scott Vargo and Commissioners discussed whether to continue sending the mask-requirement and Stage II Fire messages on Saturdays. There is concern about an increase in positive cases in the coming weeks due to the holiday weekend, as well as increased fire danger due to the high winds the county has been experiencing. Based on these concerns, Commissioners decided to continue sending them this week but the topic will be reviewed week-by-week.

Mr. Vargo has received inquiries on the status of Halloween activities, including trick-or-treat. Amy Wineland noted that, although it is still too early to make a decision, everyone wants to find a creative way to celebrate Halloween.

The group discussed the requirements for moving the county from the *Safer at Home* stage to *Protect Your Neighbor*. The county will need to show a two-week decrease in cases starting Monday, September 14, 2020.
