I. Recovery and Resilience Process

Scott Vargo, Brian Bovaird and Jaime FitzSimons gave an update on the Deep Creek Wild Fire. Summit County is working with Grand County to assist the US Forest Service in getting the fire under control.

Amy Wineland gave an update on the status of positive COVID-19 cases. She noted that cases are starting to go down once again and this will help the county stay in the Safer at Home phase. The state will examine the county's numbers in two (2) weeks to determine which phase the county will stay for a while longer.

Ms. Wineland also gave an update on two drive thru vaccination clinics that will be offered to the community on Saturday, October 10, 2020, and Wednesday, October 21, 2020 at the Summit Stage bus barn area. All community members are welcome and the vaccine will be offered free of charge.

Appointments are required. Families only need one appointment per vehicle, and can have several family members in a car. The online scheduler and clinic information is available at www.summitcountyco.gov/1389/Flu-Vaccination.

Amy Wineland and Sarah Vaine noted that the flu vaccination clinics would provide an opportunity for Public Health staff to practice drive thru vaccine distribution and test their preparedness for distributing the COVID-19 vaccine once it becomes available.

Scott Vargo shared two requests submitted to the county to hold an outdoor event at the Community & Senior Center's parking lot, and to utilize the transit facility as a food distribution location. Commissioners approved.
