


LIGHTING CUT SHEET EXAMPLES

Section 3505.07 D. of the Summit County Development Code states that all exterior fixtures shall be full cut off fixtures, which means that the bulb shall not extend below the lowest horizontal plane of the shielding element. Full cut off light fixtures do not allow light to be emitted anywhere other than directly downcast. When submitting a building permit for work which will be performed within the vicinity of exterior lights, new lights and existing lights are required to conform to these standards. A cut sheet of the proposed lighting fixtures shall be submitted with the building permit application.

If you have not yet chosen exterior light fixtures at the time of building permit submittal, you may select from these **examples** which light fixture(s) you choose for your new construction.

If you choose to select from these **examples**, fill out the bottom of this form in entirety and submit it with your building permit application. If you choose to install a different full cut off light fixture, a cut sheet must be submitted and approved by the Planning Department prior to installation.



Summit County does allow light fixtures to be equipped with a shield which brings the fixture into compliance. These shields block all light from emitting up or sideways from the fixture.
