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2006 Trend Analysis

2006 was a record year in Summit County with 70 deaths compared with 50 cases in 2004 & 2005. Of these 2006 deaths:

- 36% were autopsied with the majority having pre-existing medical conditions
- 80% all cases were male
- January was the busiest month with 11 deaths
- Wednesday was the busiest day followed by Sat, Sun & Mon
- Most frequently dispatched between 8-9am with 60% in the pm hrs.
- 40 cases with Sheriff's Dept
- 4 with State Patrol
- 9 with Dillon PD
- 9 with Breck PD
- 5 with Frisco
- 5 with Hospice













Death by Gender 2006







Cases by Month 2006




















AM Dispatch 28 PM Dispatch 42 24 hr clock 70












