A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMBULANCE LICENSE AND AMBULANCE VEHICLE PERMITS FOR THE SUMMIT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in the Colorado Emergency Medical Services Act, C.R.S., 25-3.5-101, et seq., as amended (the "Act"), and the State Board of Health Rules Pertaining to Emergency Medical Services 6 CCR 1015-3 (the "Rules"), the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado, are authorized to adopt revised Summit County Emergency Medical Services Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado ("BOCC") adopted the "Emergency Medical Service Rules and Regulations for Summit County, Colorado" on October 22, 2019 by Resolution No. 2019-77 (the "County EMS Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, the Summit Fire and Emergency Medical Services Authority ("SFE") submitted an application dated November 20, 2019 to the BOCC for approval of its ambulance license and ambulance vehicle permits pursuant to County EMS Regulations (the "Application"); and

WHEREAS, the BOCC considered the Application in accordance with applicable provisions of the County EMS Regulations including Section 3.11 and the BOCC has determined that as conditioned herein, the Application complies with the Regulations, the applicable provisions of the current EMS Act and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment rules pertaining to Ambulances and in particular that approval of the Application of the SFE ambulance license and vehicle permits would not adversely affect the existing EMS System, as such term is defined in the County EMS Regulations; and

WHEREAS, in making its determination to approve the Application, the BOCC has also specifically considered the criteria provided in County EMS Regulations Section 3.12, and the BOCC specifically finds in accordance with County EMS Regulations that Applicant's equipment and vehicles comply with the applicable provisions of the current E.M.S. Act and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment rules pertaining to Ambulances, that Applicant's equipment and vehicles comply with the requirements of the County EMS Regulations, and that the Applicant has complied in all respects with the requirements of the County EMS Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the BOCC finds that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of citizens and visitors of Summit County to approve the SFE Application for Licensure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF COLORADO THAT:

- 1. AN AMBULANCE SERVICE LICENSE IS HEREBY APPROVED FOR THE SUMMIT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY, AND**

2. AMBULANCE VEHICLE PERMITS ARE APPROVED FOR THE VEHICLES DESCRIBED IN THE SUMMIT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AUTHORITY APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE DATED NOVEMBER 20, 2019, WHICH SHALL BE DEEMED INCORPORATED HEREIN.

3. THESE APPROVALS SHALL BE EFFECTIVE ON THE TRANSFER COMPLETION DATE FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY AMBULANCE SERVICE TO SFE AS DEFINED IN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF AMBULANCES SERVICES DATED JUNE 27, 2019.
