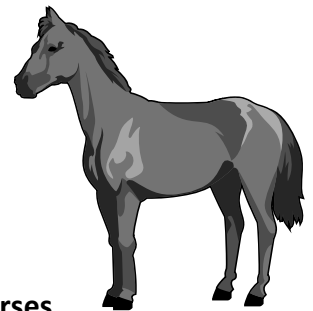


# 4-H Horseless Horse
