**PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING QUALIFYING SENIOR AND DISABLED VETERAN
PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION**

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that beginning August 1, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners of Summit County, Colorado will sit as the County Board of Equalization (CBOE) to hold hearings on appeals of decisions of the Summit County Assessor denying, in whole or in part, applications for Qualifying Senior or Disabled Veteran Property Tax Exemptions. To be eligible for appeal, property owners must have filed an application for tax exemption with the Assessor on or before July 15, 2022. The form for filing an appeal was included on the Notice of Denial or Notice of Granted in Part form provided by the Assessor. Appeals forms must be postmarked or hand delivered to the County Board of Equalization Office, P.O. Box 68, 208 East Lincoln Avenue (3rd Floor), Breckenridge, Colorado 80424, on or before August 15, 2022.
